WFE Medical Form Instructions

The Wayfinder Experience and the Ulster County Department of Health require every participant at summer camp to completely fill out our medical form. The medical form is valid for one year. Please fill out the medical form clearly and fully.

Please keep in mind that if the medical form is not completed and on file by the start of camp, your child will not be allowed to attend that camp.

Notes on the "Medical Information" Section:

You must list all medications that your child is currently taking. These medications must be in their original containers and surrendered to the Wellness Director upon registration.

*If your child will be taking different medications at different camps, a new health form must be submitted with the updated medical information.

Notes on the Immunization Section:

You must attach a copy of your child's immunization form **with your child's name clearly printed on it**. If you have chosen to opt out of immunizations, a form or letter from a health care provider or religious organization must be attached. A letter of exemption must be from one of the above and must clearly state your child's name.

Signatures:

The participant's parent or guardian must review and sign the medical form.

Dates:

_____ Your health form will be valid for one year from the date listed on the form, provided medical information does not change during that year.

You may mail your completed medical form to the Wayfinder office, along with our other waivers, before the start of camp. You may also bring your completed medical form to your camp's registration.
